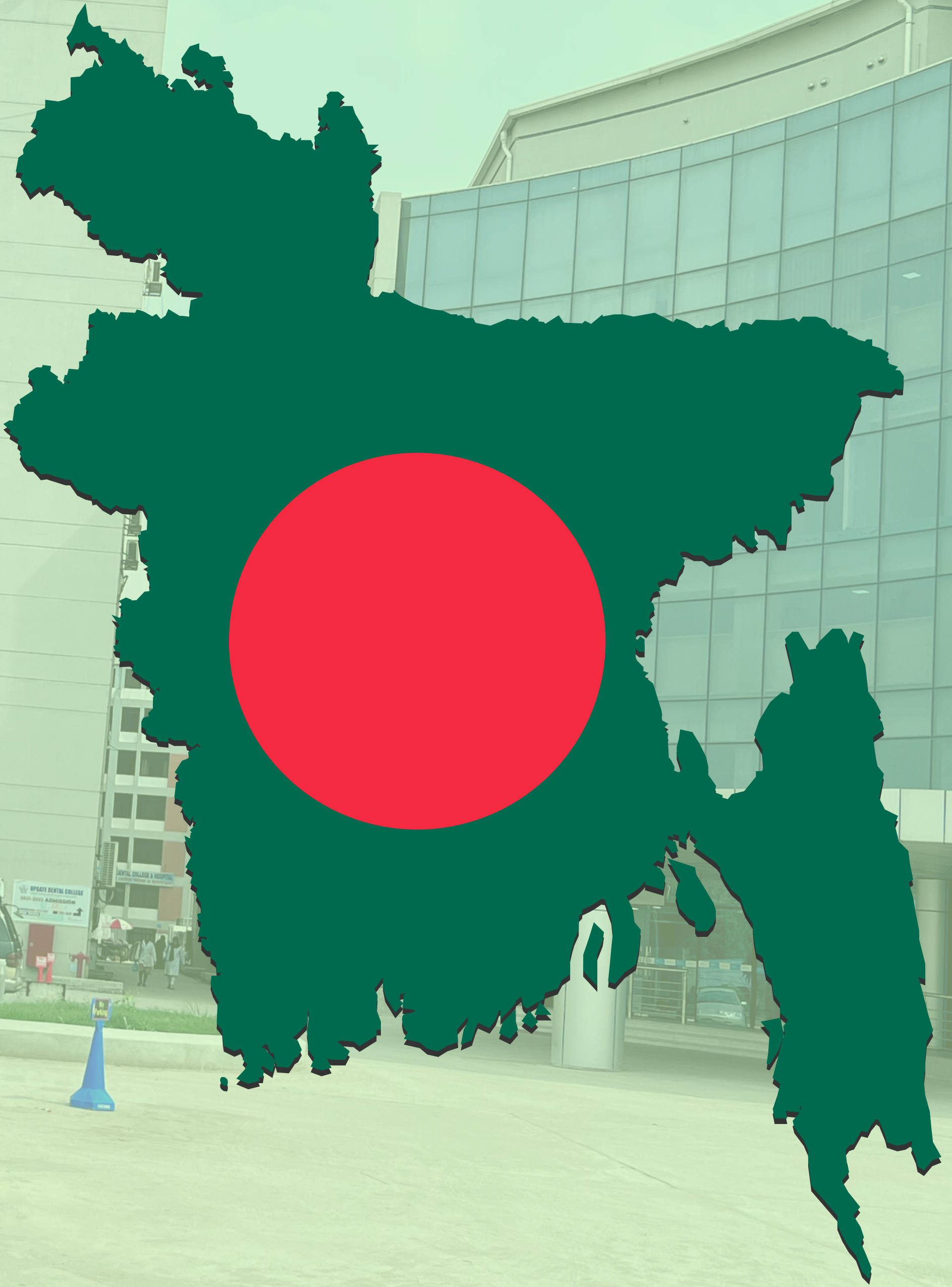

MBBS in Bangladesh Admission Process

The procedure for admission to MBBS in Bangladesh for Indian students is as follows:

- 15. University fee TT copy**
- 16. Demand draft in favor of Bangladesh High Commission**
